(1) Model FBCV series valves with the following model number format:

FBCVXX-YYY-OR ZJBBCC DD EE FF GG H where:

"XX" and "H" describe positioner options;

"YYY" and "Z" describe options for the sizes of the inlet and outlet ports;

"J" is either "A" or "1" designating the valve body interior surface finish;

"BB" is either "EP" or "LN" and designates the two sanitary plug (stem) designs;

"CC" is either "A1," "A3," or "A5," designating the plug (stem) surface finish;

"DD" is either "BN," "EP," "SI," "VI," or "KZ," designating the 3-A acceptable O-ring materials;

"EE" describes the actuator type and exterior coating;

"FF" describes the position in which the actuator opens the valve; and

"GG" describes accessories

(2) Model FB5CPM and FB6CPM series valves with the following model number format:

FB(5 or 6) CPM-YYY-6L AjAkDmnJLpq where:

"YYY" designates the size of the inlet/outlet ports;

"J" is a capacity designator for the valve body;

"k" is a flow capacity designator for the plug design;

"DD" is either "BN," "EJ," "TY," "VI," or "KZ," designating the 3-A acceptable O-ring materials;

"mn" describes the loader range;

"JL" specifies the 3-A specific Jorlon (gylon) diaphragm; and

"pq" describes the actuator.
